

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-170**

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY  
MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY  
MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM  
OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
UNITS ALLOWING ENTRY TO ORMOC CITY BY THEIR  
RESIDENTS WHO ARE IN POSSESSION OF QR CODES  
DOWNLOADED FROM THE SAFEORMOC APPLICATION.**

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated June 8, 2020 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor or Acting City Mayor the authority to sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Local Government Units allowing entry to Ormoc City by their residents who are in possession of QR codes downloaded from the SafeOrmoc application. Further requesting that this matter be treated as EXTREMELY URGENT, a copy of the MOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the Local Government of Ormoc an entity created under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines is hereinafter referred to as the "LGU-ORMOC/ ORMOC CITY";

WHEREAS, contact tracing has been proven effective in controlling the spread of infectious diseases to the community;

WHEREAS, in order to effectively implement contact tracing in the community the City finds it proper to require residents of LGUs outside Ormoc City, who would want to enter the City, to provide border passes before permitted entry to the City;

WHEREAS, the LGU, mindful of its mandate under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code (LGC), to deliver basic services and facilities and pursuant to its power to enter contracts/agreements and other cooperative arrangements relative to, among others, the delivery of basic services, uphold the general welfare, promote the health and safety of its inhabitants and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people;

WHEREAS, the subject MOA clearly and plainly encapsulate the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and obligations towards the attainment of the lofty ends of the same, and this Sanggunian, upon thorough review, finds that the same is entered into for the best interests of the City and its constituents, and therefore, is most deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Chairman, Committee on Justice & Peace & Order and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Vincent L. Rama, Lalaine A. Marcos, Esteban V. Laurente and Joan Marbie C. Simbajon; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS ALLOWING ENTRY TO ORMOC CITY BY THEIR RESIDENTS WHO ARE IN POSSESSION OF QR CODES DOWNLOADED FROM THE SAFEORMOC APPLICATION;



# MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made and entered on \_\_\_\_\_, by and between:

**THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC** an entity created under Republic Act No. 179, existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with address at New Ormoc City Hall, Aunubing St., Barangay Cogon, Ormoc City, Leyte, Philippines, represented in this act by **RICHARD I. GOMEZ**, in his capacity as the City Mayor of Ormoc City, hereinafter referred to as the "LGU-ORMOC/ ORMOC CITY".

## WITNESSETH, THAT:

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Ormoc, in the advent of COVID-19 transmissions in nearby localities, has implemented ways and means to control, if not contain, the transmission of COVID-19 in the City;

**WHEREAS**, contact tracing has been proven effective in controlling the spread of infectious diseases to the community;

**WHEREAS**, in order to effectively implement contact tracing in the community the City finds it proper to require residents of LGUs outside Ormoc City, who would want to enter the City, to provide border passes before permitted entry to the City;

**WHEREAS**, the LGU, mindful of its mandate under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code (LGC), to deliver basic services and facilities and pursuant to its power to enter contracts/agreements and other cooperative arrangements relative to, among others, the delivery of basic services, uphold the general welfare, promote the health and safety of its inhabitants and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing premises and subject to the terms, conditions, covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, the Parties covenant and agree as follows:

- a. To provide Border Passes, with QR Codes, to its residents that can be used to track/trace the said individuals upon entry to Ormoc City;
- i. The Border Pass shall be used while within and when going around the territorial jurisdiction of Ormoc.
- ii. When entering the premises of public or private establishments in Ormoc City.
- b. The said Border pass shall provide the following information:
- i. Full name
- ii. Address

- iii. Age
- iv. Contact Details (email address or cellphone number)
- v. Civil Status
- vi. Gender
- c. To assist LGU-ORMOC upon contact tracing activity involving the residents of the LGU of Origin;
- d. Frequently monitor and update the number of Border passes issued to its residents;
- e. Assign contact tracing teams to immediately coordinate with LGU-ORMOC if and when contact tracing is necessary;

## II. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF LGU-ORMOC:

- a. To authorize personnel manning Ormoc borders to require persons entering Ormoc City to present Border passes with the right QR Code; and to further require the presentation of a valid identification card to confirm the identity of the holder;
- b. To deny entry to residents of LGUs who do not possess the required border pass;
- c. To ensure the confidentiality of the data collected which shall be used solely for contact tracing of individuals with close contact to an identified COVID+ individual;
- d. To designate contact tracing teams for immediate coordination between LGUs involved;

## III. AMENDMENTS

This Memorandum of Agreement shall not be revoked, revised, and amended or modified in any respect except by mutual consent in writing of contracting parties.

## IV. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION

This AGREEMENT shall take effect upon signing by the two parties and shall remain in force until revoked by the concerned parties and/or higher authorities, subject to a written notice given thirty (30) days in advance.
