# RESOLUTION NO. 2020-181

AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ TO DISPOSE OF THE FOLLOWING NON-PERFORMING **ASSETS** WASTE MATERIALS, TO WIT:

- SERVICE VEHICLES, HEAVY EQUIPMENT AND MOTORCYCLES
- 2. METAL SCRAPS
- 3. TIKES
- 4. DAMAGED SCHOOL SUPPLIES
- 5. EXPIRED FOOD ITEMS
- 6. FARK AND PLAZA SIGNAGES
- 7. SKATING RINK, AND
- 8. PUBLIC LIBRARY

INCLUDING THE AUTHORITY TO PERFORM ALL NECESSARY ACTS FOR THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE SAME, SUBJECT TO THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT (COA) **OTHER** AND RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Fifteenth Sanggunian was in receipt of an Endorsement Letter dated 10 February 2020 from the Office of the City Mayor requesting for the passage of a Resolution granting him authority to dispose of the abovementioned non-performing assets and waste materials of the Local Government Unit of Ormoc City, subject to the Commission on Audit and Other Rules and Regulations.

WHEREAS, Section 379 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly provides that when property of any local government unit has become unserviceable for any cause or is no longer needed, it shall, upon application of the officer accountable therefore, be inspected and appraised by the provincial, city or municipal auditor, as the case may be, or his duly authorized representative or that of the Commission on Audit and, if found valueless or unusable, shall be destroyed in the presence of the inspecting officer;

WHEREAS, further, pursuant to Section 79 of Presidential Decree No. 1445, otherwise known as the Government Auditing Code of the Philippines, likewise mandates that "When government property has become unserviceable for any cause or no longer needed, it shall, upon application of the officer accountable therefore, be inspected by the head of the agency or of his duly authorized representative";

WHEREAS, in several Inventory and Inspection Report of Unserviceable Property (IIRUP) all dated 30 June 2018 certified by the City General Services Officer (CGSO), service vehicles, heavy equipment and motorcycles were exposed to bad elements for a long time resulting in its substantial depreciation had been declared beyond economic;

WHEREAS, in several endorsement letters from the CGSO addressed to the City Mayor, the former endorsed to the latter Waste Material Reports for his approval to proceed with proper disposal procedure of the metal scraps, tires, damaged school supplies and expired food items, copies of the said letters are hereto attached as Annex "A", "B", "C" and "D" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, likewise in another endorsement letter dated 2 August 2019, the CGSO endorsed to the City Mayor documents pertinent to the demolition of the Public Library, as the same is considered public nuisance, ruinous, dangerous, very dilapidated and poses great risk and hazard to passersby, a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex "E" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, park and plaza signages as well as the skating rink identified and specified per IIRUP are recommended to be demolished for safety and aesthetic considerations of the area as the said structures are imposing yet not beautifying the City;

WHEREAS, the City Disposal Committee on 28 January 2020 endorsed documents pertinent to the City's proposed disposal of non-performing assets and waste materials to the Office of the City Mayor for further endorsement to the Commission on Audit for latter's appraisal and review, a copy of the endorsement is hereto attached as Annex "F" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in a communication dated 15 June 2020 from the City Legal Officer stated therein that the subject properties for disposal fall within the definition of being beyond economic repair or are already obsolete, junk and unserviceable, further finds nothing legally objectionable to the proposed disposal and that the same is not inconsistent with the law and public policy;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds, that the requested authorization to the City Mayor will further facilitate the expeditious disposal of unserviceable property and aid the disposal committee to undertake the disposition of said properties, subject to COA and Other Rules and Regulations, and that the same is most beneficial to the City, therefore, meriting this august Body's full support and favorable action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Roiland H. Villasencio, Chairman, Committee on Public Properties, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Peter M. Rodriguez, Nolito M. Quilang, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lalaine A. Marcos, Esteban V. Laurente and Joan Marbie C. Simbajon; be it
