RESOLUTION NO. 2020-223

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL WORK PROGRAM (AWP) IN THE AMOUNT OF MILLION **PHILIPPINE PESOS** (PHP2,000.000.00) FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2020 CONONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) PROGRAM, ACTIVITY AND **PROJECTS** (PAPS) TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF ENERGY REGULATION (ER) 1-94 FUND.

WHEREAS, the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an urgent Indorsement Letter from the City Mayor's Office (CMO) dated July 17, 2020 respectfully endorsing the Supplemental Annual Work Program (AWP) for the calendar year 2020 for COVID-19 related Program, Activity and Projects (PAPs) to be funded out of the city's share for Energy Regulation (ER) 1-94 Fund and requesting for the passage of a resolution approving the same;

WHEREAS, Section 5 (i) of Republic Act No. 7638, otherwise known as the "Department of Energy Act of 1992" mandates the Department of Energy (DOE) to devise ways and means of giving direct benefits to the province, city, or municipality, especially the community and people affected, and equitable preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating-facility;

WHEREAS, the DOE promulgated Energy Regulations No. 1-94 (ER 1-94) on August 1, 1994 to operationalize the implementation of Section 5 (i) of Republic Act No. 7638, which regulation provides for the nature of benefits and scope of benefits the community and people affected, the pertinent host local government unit (LGU) shall be entitled to from the energy resource developer or power producer;

WHEREAS, under ER No. 1-94, the energy source and generation company and/or energy resource developer shall set aside One Centavo per Kilowatt-Hour (P0.01/kWh) of the total electricity sales as financial benefit of the host local government communities and regions;

WHEREAS, as home to the largest producer of geothermal energy in the country, the Energy Development Corporation (EDC), Ormoc City is considered as a Host LGU as defined by DC2018-08-0021;

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the President issued Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to the COVID-19;

WHEREAS, as a response, the DOE issued Department Circular No. 2020-04-00080 entitled "Rationalizing the Utilization of ER 1-94 Funds by Host Local Government Units in Response to COVID-19 Public Health Emergency" which took effect last April 6, 2020 stating that Host LGUs can now use these funds to undertake their duty to mitigate, if not, contain the COVID-19 and issuing the corresponding framework to utilize ER 1-94 Funds to boister their efforts to the COVID-19 crisis in their respective areas;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian previously passed an Appropriation Ordinance No. 2020-015 appropriating the ER 1-94 Fund in the amount of Thirty Million Two Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Seven Philippine Pesos and Sixty-Three Cents (Php30,293,757.63) for provision of 5% Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Fund and LGU Support to COVID-19 related programs;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Annual Work Program for the Year 2020 provided that Two Million Philippines Pesos (Php2,000,000.00) of the aforementioned Fund will be for the procurement of Logistic, Equipment, and Supplies for the efficient function of Ormoc City Molecular Laboratory for COVID-19 located at OSPA-Farmers Medical Center Hospital;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian finds the request of the City Mayor's Office as truly beneficial and will immensely be favorable to City of Ormoc and its constituents, and therefore, most deserving of this august Body's utmost and favorable consideration;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Peter M. Rodriguez, Chairman, Committee on Finance & Appropriation, severally seconded by SP Members Nolito M. Quilang, Roiland H. Villasencio, Vincent L. Rama, Lalaine A. Marcos, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon, Tomas R. Serafica, Esteban V. Laurente and Gregorio G. Yrastorza III; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL WORK PROGRAM (AWP) IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP 2,000.000.00) FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2020 FOR CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) RELATED PROGRAM, ACTIVITY AND PROJECTS (PAPS) TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE CITY'S SHARE OF ENERGY REGULATION (ER) 1-94 FUND;
