APPROVING A RESOLUTION THE CITY **FISHERIES** MANAGEMENT PLAN (CY 2021-2026) AND THEREBY ADOPTING CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 5, SERIES OF 2020.

WHEREAS, the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received an Endorsement dated July 17, 2020 from the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez forwarding the City Development Council (CDC) Resolution No. 5, Series of 2020, entitled: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT PLAN CY 2021 -2026 AND REQUESTING THE HONORABLE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE SAME";
