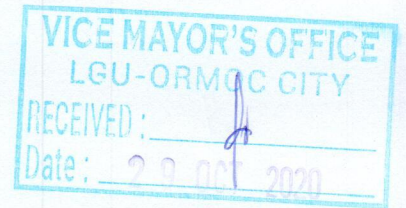

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-340**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNUAL WORK PROGRAM (AWP) IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP741,750.00) FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2020 FOR THE PROVISION OF BACKYARD MUSCOVY DUCKS AS ALTERNATIVE LIVELIHOOD FOR FAMILIES WITH MALNOURISHED CHILDREN IN ORMOC CITY TO BE FUNDED OUT FROM THE DEVELOPMENT AND LIVELIHOOD FUND (DLF) OF ENERGY REGULATION NUMBER 1-94 (ER NO. 1-94).**

WHEREAS, the 15<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an indorsement letter from the City Mayor's Office, dated September 24, 2020, requesting for the passage of a resolution approving the AWP in the amount of SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP741,750.00) for the Calendar Year 2020 for the provision of backyard Muscovy ducks as alternative livelihood for families with malnourished children in Ormoc City to be funded out from the city's share of the DLF of ER No. 1-94;

WHEREAS, the City Agriculture Office submitted a project proposal entitled: "Provision of Backyard Muscovy Ducks as Alternative Livelihood for Families with Malnourished Children in Ormoc City" which aims to decrease the number of malnourished children. The same suggests that supplying eggs to the families of malnourished children is effective in addressing protein deficiency common among malnourished children. Below are some of the details of the proposal:

WHEREAS, the project proposal identified 215 target beneficiaries coming from ten (10) Barangays in Ormoc City with high incidence of wasting, namely: Nueva Sociedad, Dayhagan, Punta, Danhug, Hugpa, Domonar, Can-untog, Biliboy, Lake Danao, and Cabintan;

WHEREAS, the City Agriculture Office found that the Muscovy Ducks are more appropriate for dispersal among poor families since these fowls are self-sufficient, less vulnerable to diseases, and weighs more than other ordinary duck species. Hence, the beneficiaries would not only benefit from the eggs that these ducks produce but also from the meat of these ducks;

WHEREAS, Section 5 (i) of Republic Act No. 7638, otherwise known as the "Department of Energy Act of 1992" mandates the Department of Energy (DOE) to devise ways and means of giving direct benefits to the province, city, or municipality especially the community and people affected, and equitable preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating-facility;

WHEREAS, the DOE promulgated Energy Regulations No. 1-94 on August 1, 1994 to implement Section 5 (i) of RA No. 7638, which regulation provides for the nature of benefits the community and people affected, the pertinent host local government unit (LGU) shall be entitled to from the energy resource developer or power producer;

WHEREAS, Section 3 (3.1) of DOE Department Circular No. DC2018-08-0021, provides that the AWP shall be supported by a Resolution from the respective Local Government Unit (LGU) certifying that the tangible projects is in accordance with their respective CDP, CLUP, RDP, RPFP, ADSDPP, and IPDP, whichever is applicable;

WHEREAS, the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) attests that the said project proposal is in accordance with the City Development Plan and is included in the Annual Investment Plan of the City Government of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds the request not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and the aim is important and beneficial to the City of Ormoc as it contributes to the goal of reducing malnutrition and making children healthy and better prepared for their future and so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

NOW, THEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Nolito M. Quilang, Chairman of the Committee on Employment, Livelihood, and Manpower Development, and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Vice-Chairman of the Committee on Social Welfare, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, severally seconded by SP Members Roiland H. Villasencio, Esteban V. Laurente, Tomas R. Serafica, Peter M. Rodriguez, Lalaine A. Marcos, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Jasper M. Lucero and Joan Marbie C. Simbajan; be it
