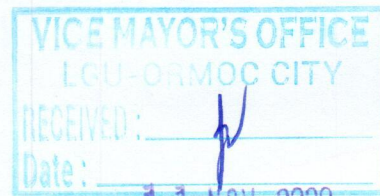
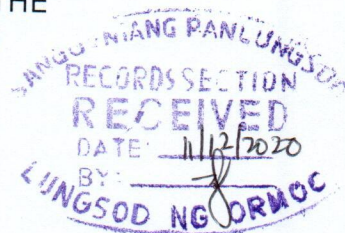

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-369

**A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING BUSINESS
ESTABLISHMENTS, SCHOOLS, GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND
BARANGAYS IN ORMOC CITY TO HANG TARPAILINS IN
SUPPORT OF THE ANNUAL 18 DAY CAMPAIGN TO END
VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN STARTING NOVEMBER 25
UNTIL ITS CULMINATION ON DECEMBER 12.**

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of a letter dated November 3, 2020 from the city's Integrated Population Gender and Development Office (IPGDO) requesting to pass a Resolution encouraging business establishments, schools, government offices and barangays to hang tarpaulins in support of the annual 18 Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW), which campaign begins on November 25 and ends on December 12;

WHEREAS, the IPGDO is requesting further that the tarpaulins be displayed in a conspicuous place, adding that their Office shall provide the tarpaulin design for the purpose of uniformity and that business establishments, schools, government offices and barangays need only to come to them to secure said tarpaulin design;

WHEREAS, said request, which was coursed through SP Member Lalaine A. Marcos as Chairperson of the Committee on Women, Family and Gender Development finds that the request of IPGDO is not contrary to law, morals, good customs, public policy, or public order;

WHEREAS, such request even affirms the mandate in Proclamation 1172 s. 2006, Declaring November 25 to December 12 of Every Year as the "18 Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women", wherein "all departments and agencies of the national government, including state colleges and universities, Local Government Units (LGUs) and all other sectors of society are enjoined to actively support and participate in the protection of human rights of women against violence and all other forms of discrimination";

WHEREAS, the IPGDO request is in line with the City Ordinance No. 021, Series of 2017, "AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE NO. 181 SERIES OF 2013 ENTITLED, "GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT CODE OF ORMOC CITY"," specifically Section 21, a.3, Advocacy and Campaign Management, which reads, "A coordinated advocacy and campaign on all forms of discrimination and violence against women shall be programmed";

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Lalaine A. Marcos, Chairman Committee on Women, Family and Gender Development, severally seconded by SP Members Nolito M. Quilang, Tomas R. Serafica, Esteban V. Laurente, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Peter M. Rodriguez, Roiland H. Villasencio, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III and Jasper M. Lucero; be it


