A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BY AND BETWEEN THE AGRICULTURAL TRAINING INSTITUTE RYC 8 AND THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC, THE **ENHANCEMENT** OF THE INFORMATION AND TECHNOLOGY SERVICES CENTER UNDER THE RICE COMPETITIVENESS ENHANCEMENT FUND (RCEF).

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated October 12, 2020 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor or Acting City Mayor the authority to sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by and between the Agricultural Training Institute – RTC 8 and the City Government of Ormoc, for the enhancement of the Farmers Information and Technology Services (FITS) Center under the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund (RCEF), a copy of the MOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in an Opinion dated October 17, 2020, the City Legal Office finds nothing legally objectionable in the said MOA and that the same is not contrary to law, morals, public order, or public policy much less detrimental to the best interest of Ormoc City, a copy of the Opinion is hereto attached as "ANNEX B" and made an integral part hereof;

### MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

ENHANCEMENT OF THE FARMERS' INFORMATION AND TECHNOLOGY SERVICES CENTER UNDER THE RICE COMPETITIVENESS ENHANCEMENT FUND (RCEF)

### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and among:

The AGRICULTURAL TRAINING INSTITUTE – RTC 8, the extension and training arm of the Department of Agriculture, herein represented by its Center Director, HAZEL GRACE T. TAGANAS, with official address at VSU, Baybay City, Leyte and hereinafter referred to as ATI-RTC 8;

and

The LGU - ORMOC CITY, a government organization herein represented by Hon. RICHARD I. GOMEZ, City Mayor, with official address at Ormoc City, Leyte and hereinafter referred to as the LGU ORMOC CITY;

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, as the lead agency in extension services under the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund (RCEF), the Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) has come up with strategies to enhance the access of the rice farmers to information relevant to them. Among these is the collaboration with Farmers' Information and Technology Services (FITS) Centers nationwide to deliver information and technology services in the barangay level;

WHEREAS, under the extension component, ATI aims to enhance the access to information of the rice farmers by tapping the Farmers' Information and Technology Services (FITS) Centers in the identified priority areas. This is by supporting FITS Centers that are located in the city local government units (LGUs) to establish "satellite" FITS Centers in selected barangays in their area to be known as "Barangay FITS Kiosks". Through this, ATI aims to make information more accessible and available to the target beneficiaries of RCEF as well as increase awareness and understanding of the farmer sin the countryside towards RTL, RCEF, and DA's rice—related programs and services.

WHEREAS, Ormoc City is a rice-producing city and is one of the target areas for the RCEF;

WHEREAS, LGU – Ormoc City established its FITS Center in January 31, 2007 and is one the most active FITS Centers in Eastern Visayas;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties do hereby mutually agree on the following:

and

## Obligations of the ATI-RTC 8:

- Provide fund for the materials and services needed thru fund transfer to LGU-Ormoc City in the amount of One hundred forty-five thousand pesos only (PhP145,000.00) to be utilized as follows, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations:
- a. The five identified barangays shall have a budget of **Php25,000 each** for the creation/establishment of a display of IEC materials in strategic/accessible locations. IEC materials can be flyers, brochures, posters, magazines, and guides related to RCEF and its components, rice farming technologies, and other relevant information. The budget shall also cover the expenses for the FITS kiosk signage to be installed by the barangay LGU; and
- b. The remaining Php20,000 from the total funds shall be used for the enhancement of the FITS Center Ormoc City to be used to a) conduct a briefing for the staff of the five selected barangay LGUs regarding RCEF and its components; and b) complement the FITS Center IEC/ICT strategies through the display, dissemination, packaging, and/or reproduction of materials, and provision of technology advisory services related to RCEF and the rice industry.
- Coordinate with ATI-ISD and other institutions in their area such as the Partner Member Agency (PMA); DA bureaus, attached agencies, and regional field offices; and state universities and colleges—for the provision of IEC materials to the FITS Center and Barangay FITS Kiosks enhanced under RCEF;
- 3. Conduct capability-building and updating activities on RCEF services and rice technologies, such as briefings, seminars, training, if necessary, for FITS Center/Kiosk staff and/or the Magsasaka Siyentista (MS); and
- 4. Conduct monitoring and documentation of the project.

# Obligations of LGU - Ormoc City's FITS Center:

- Institutionalize the promotion of RCEF and the DA's Rice Program as part of their services;
- Provide complementary manpower for the delivery of rice- and RCEFrelated information and technology services to clients;
- 3. Identify 5 rice-producing barangays as sites for the Barangay FITS Kiosks;
- Conduct briefing/orientation for Barangay FITS Kiosk staff regarding RCEF and other relevant information, which can also be coordinated with concerned agencies such as the ATI-RTC 8;
- Assist and supervise the Barangay FIT Kiosks in the implementation of the project;
- Develop, translate, package, and disseminate IEC materials related to rice and RCEF, including any best practices;
- Support local rice farmers including the MS in adopting and promoting rice production practices and technologies;

- 8. Ensure the accessibility of FITS Center services during office hours to farmer-visitors and other stakeholders requesting for information, advisory, and other related services on rice and RCEF;
- 9. Promote the services of the FITS Center and Barangay FITS Kiosks to targeted clients;
- Gather IEC materials related to rice an RCEF from other institutions, for distribution to clients;
- 11. Ensure that the materials, supplies, another provisions provided under the project are properly used and/or maintained in good condition;
- 12. Liquidate in a timely manner the funds transferred to LGU-Ormoc City in the amount of **one hundred forty-five thousand pesos only (PhP145, 000.00)** for the establishment of the 5 Barangay FITS Kiosks subject to the government's accounting and auditing guidelines.
- 13. Distribute the allocated fund of wenty-five thousand pesos (PhP 25,000.00) to each of the 5 concerned Barangays for the establishment of the respective Barangay FITS Kipsks subject to timely liquidation and submission to the City Agriculture Office; and,
- 14. Prepare and submit consolidated monthly accomplishment reports of the FITS Center and Barangay FITS Klosks to the ATL-RTC 8.

### EFFECTIVITY

This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing by all parties and shall be in full force and effect until the satisfactory fulfillment of all its terms and conditions. Any amendment and/or modification to this Agreement shall be made in writing upon mutual consent by both parties concerned.
