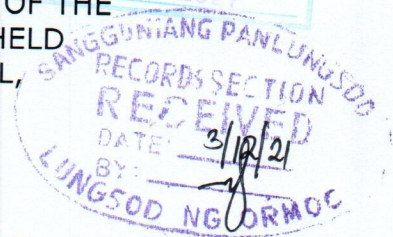
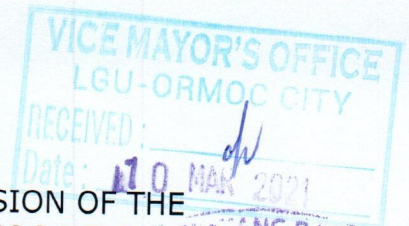

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNUAL WORK
PROGRAM (AWP) FOR THE YEAR 2021 FOR COVID-19
RELATED PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS
(PAPs) TO BE FUNDED OUT OF THE ENERGY
REGULATION (ER) 1-94 FUNDS PURSUANT TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY CIRCULAR NO. DC2020-04-
00080.**

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Article II of the Philippine Constitution sets forth the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11332 mandates the President of the Republic of the Philippines to declare a State of Public Health Emergency in the event of any epidemic of national and/or international concern which threatens national security for the purpose of mobilizing governmental and non-governmental agencies to respond;

WHEREAS, in the light of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak in the Philippines, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines and enjoining all government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs) to render full assistance and cooperation to mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the COVID-19 thereof;

WHEREAS, for the purpose of giving broader powers to the President to address the COVID-19 dilemma, including the authority to identify and allocate funds in relation thereto, Congress passed RA 11469 entitled "Bayanihan to Heal as One Act" which has already taken effect;

WHEREAS, Sec 4(g) of RA 11469 directs "LGUs to act within the letter and spirit of all directives, rules and regulations of the National Government, exercise their autonomy on matters undefined by the National Government or within parameters that it has set";

WHEREAS, RA 7638 (otherwise known as the DOE Act of 1992), the DOE is mandated to devise ways and means of giving direct benefit to the province, city, or municipality, especially the community and people affected, and equitable preferential benefit to the region that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating facility;

WHEREAS, as a response, the DOE issued Department Order (DO) Circular No. 2020-04-00080 entitled "Rationalizing the Utilization of ER 1-94 Funds by Host Local Government Units in Response to COVID-19 Public Health Emergency" which took effect last April 6, 2020 stating that Host LGUs can now use these funds to undertake their duty to mitigate, if not, contain the COVID-19 and issuing the corresponding framework to utilize ER 1-94 Funds to bolster their efforts to the COVID-19 crisis in their respective areas;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent endorsement letter dated February 23, 2021 from the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez respectfully endorsing to the office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the herein Annual Work Program (AWP) for the year 2021 for COVID-19 related PAPs to be funded out of the City's share of ER 1-94 and requesting for the passage of resolution approving the same. Copy of AWP 2021 is hereto attached as Annex "A";

WHEREAS, the City Legal Officer has reviewed the said Annual Work Program (AWP) for the year 2021 for the COVID-19 related PAPs and found nothing legally objectionable, adding that there is no contrary to law, morals, public order or public policy, much less detrimental to the best interest of the Ormoc City LGU;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Lalaine A. Marcos, Chairman, Committee on Environment, Natural Resources, and Energy Conservation, and SP Member Peter M. Rodriguez, Chairman, Committee on Finance and Appropriation, severally seconded by SP Members Nolito M. Quilang, Jasper M. Lucero, Roiland H. Villasencio, Vincent L. Rama, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon, Tomas R. Serafica, Esteban V. Laurente and Gregorio G. Yrastorza III; be it




