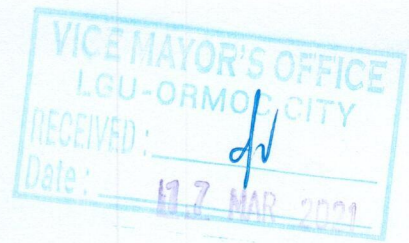

**A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY ENDORSING TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT (DBM)
THE STREET LIGHTING PROJECT ALONG BARANGAYS
COGON (ROTUNDA) - SAN PABLO - LUNA - DOLORES -
MILAGRO ROADS IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN
MILLION TEN THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS
(PHP15,010,000.00) TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE FY
2021 LOCAL GOVERNMENT SUPPORT FUND -
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT
UNITS (LGSF - FA TO LGUs) AND THE SAME IS PART OF
THE DULY APPROVED LOCAL DEVELOPMENT
INVESTMENT PROGRAM (LDIP) FOR CY 2021-2023
AND ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR CY
2021 OF THE CITY.**

WHEREAS, street lighting provides a number of important benefits. It improves safety for homeowners, businesses, institutions, pedestrians and motorists. There are areas of the roads that are dark and not illuminated due to the absence or lack of street lighting system. Thus, the roads that are not illuminated compromise the safety and comfort of road users, riding public and residents around the area; the safety and convenience of Ormoc City's motorists and pedestrians is a primordial concern that should be addressed by the City;

WHEREAS, an endorsement dated March 4, 2021 was submitted to this august Body requesting for the issuance of a Resolution endorsing the proposed Street Lighting Project along Barangays of Cogon (Rotunda) - San Pablo-Luna-Dolores-Milagro Roads in the amount of FIFTEEN MILLION TEN THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP15,010,000.00) to be funded under the FY 2021 Local Government Support Fund - Financial Assistance to Local Government Units (LGSF-FA to LGU's) and that the same project is part of the duly approved Local Development Investment Program and Annual Investment Program (FY 2021) of the City Government of Ormoc, a photocopy of the approved Project Proposal for FY 2021 LGSF-FA to LGUs of said project is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the requested resolution is pursuant to the requirements set under Item 3.0 of the Local Budget Circular (LBC) No. 131 dated January 8, 2021 with the subject, "Guidelines on the Release and Utilization of the Local Government Support Fund - Financial Assistance to Local Government Units (LGSF-FA to LGUs) in the FY 2021 General Appropriations Act, Republic Act (RA) No. 11518;

WHEREAS, LGSF-FA to LGUs serves as the National Government's response to the various challenges faced by the LGUs in the exercise of their devolved service delivery functions, foremost of which is the raising of sufficient funds for local development. Hence, LGSF was included in the FY 2021 General Appropriations Act to cover, among other, financial assistance to LGUs as support for its priority programs and projects;

WHEREAS, to recall this Sanggunian passed Resolution No. 2020-236 last August 4, 2020 approving the CY 2021 Annual Investment Program (AIP) and Resolution No. 2020-235 approving the Local Development Investment Program (LDIP) for the CY 2021-2023 of the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, the Street Lighting Project is part of the aforementioned approved resolutions after being identified and determined to be consistent with the City's development thrust to provide efficient public service and better quality of life for Ormocanons. Thus, this Sanggunian fully supports the City Mayor's intention of favorably forwarding the said project to be covered under the LGSF-FA program.

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Esteban V. Laurente, Chairman Committee on Infrastructure Development, severally seconded by SP Members Roiland H. Villasencio, Tomas R. Serafica, Peter M. Rodriguez, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Jasper M. Lucero, Vincent L. Rama and Lalaine A. Marcos; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass RESOLUTION EARNESTLY ENDORSING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT (DBM) THE STREET LIGHTING PROJECT ALONG BARANGAYS COGON (ROTUNDA) - SAN PABLO - LUNA - DOLORES - MILAGRO ROADS IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN MILLION TEN THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (P15,010,000.00) TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE FY 2021 LOCAL GOVERNMENT SUPPORT FUND - FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGSF - FA TO LGUs) AND THE SAME IS PART OF THE DULY APPROVED LOCAL DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROGRAM (LDIP) FOR CY 2021-2023 AND ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) FOR CY 2021 OF THE CITY;
