A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH NAYUTA CO., LTD REGARDING SSDC STREET-LIGHT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated May 24, 2021 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor or Acting City Mayor the authority to sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Nayuta Co., LTD regarding SSDC Street-Light Project, a copy of the MOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in an Opinion dated May 20, 2021, the City Legal Office finds nothing legally objectionable in the said MOA and that the same is not contrary to law, morals, public order, or public policy much less detrimental to the best interests of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, one of the Social Development Goals of Nayuta Co., LTD is to solve the social issues faced by its partner-LGU by using its own technologies and products;

WHEREAS, this initiative requires the support of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Private Sector Partnership through the Official Development Assistance (ODA) of the Government of Japan in an effort to reduce poverty and address other challenges in partner countries while effectively mobilizing Japan's human, technical, and financial resources;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the MOA is to maintain a cooperative relationship with each other for the social improvement and sustainability project for disaster and crime problems with intelligent independent network street-light (SSDC Street-light Project;

### MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is made and entered into this\_\_\_\_\_of \_\_\_\_2021 by and among:

The CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC, a political subdivision, existing and created by virtue of Philippine law, represented by RICHARD I. GOMEZ, City Mayor of Ormoc City, pursuant to Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution No.\_\_\_\_\_\_, with office address at 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, City Mayor's Office, New Ormoc City Hall, Aunubing St., Cogon, Ormoc City, hereinafter referred to as the "FIRST PARTY";

- and -

The NAYUTA CO., Ltd, a duly organized corporation, existing and registered by virtue of Japanese law, represented by MASAHIKO SUGIYAMA, Chief Executive Officer, pursuant to Board Resolution No.\_\_\_\_\_\_, with principal address at 398 Jokocho Higashi, Hamamatsu, Shizuoka 431-3103 Japan, hereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY".

### WITNESSETH, that:

WHEREAS, the SDGs activity of the SECOND PARTY has a mission to solve the social issues faced by the FIRST PARTY by using own technologies and products, and aims to realize further overseas expansion. This initiative requires the support of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Private Sector Partnership and is indispensable;

WHEREAS, JICA carries out Official Development Assistance (ODA) for the government of Japan in an effort to reduce poverty and address other challenges in partner countries while effectively mobilizing Japan's human, technical and financial resources;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is one of the government units whose mandate is to protect the life of citizens and communities, clarify social issues, and strive to improve and maintain them according to their priorities:

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the RA 7160 or Local Government Code of 1991 provides that "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare."

WHEREAS the missions of the FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY are in line with each other. Therefore, this MOA is to maintain a cooperative relationship will each for the social improvement and sustainability project for disaster and crime problems with intelligent independent network street-light (SSDC Street-light Project)

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties above do hereby mutually agree the following:

1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this MOA is to set forth the terms and conditions, scope of work and responsibilities of the parties associated with their collaboration on "Social improvement and sustainability project for disaster and crime problems with intelligent independent network street-light (SSDC Street-light Project)".

- 2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY The FIRST PARTY shall undertake the following activities under this MOA:
- 2.1. Researching and providing information requested by the SECOND PARTY for this project;
- 2.2. Connecting organizations that will cooperate in the development, operation and maintenance of the products and services used for this project with the SECOND PARTY;
  - 2.3. Getting cooperation with the local citizens and organizations;
- 2.4. Setting budget for the maintenance operation after achieving the project.
- 3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY The SECOND PARTY shall undertake the following activities under this MOA:
- 3.1. Securing approval from JICA's private sector collaboration "Feasibility Survey with the Private Sector for Utilizing Japanese Technologies in CDA Projects (SECOND PARTY ODA F/S)"
- 3.2. After complying and obtaining the preceding paragraph 3.1, the SECOND PARTY will conduct field surveys and product tests, and submit the resulting documents to the FIRST PARTY and JICA;
- 3.3. Securing approval from JICA's private sector collaboration project "Verification Survey with Private Sector for Disseminating Japanese Technologies (SECOND PARTY Verification Survey);
- 3.4. After complying and obtaining the preceding paragraph 3.3, the SECOND PARTY will achieve the goal of this project.

## 4. CONFIDENTIALITY:

- 4.1. It is prohibited to disclose confidential information obtained to anyone other than both parties and their related parties in this MOA. Confidential information is every information that has been declared and described as "Confidential" in advance;
- 4.2. Each party shall manage the confidential information with the same degree of care as that of the prudent manager, and shall not disclose or divulge any confidential information to any third party without the prior written approval of the disclosing party;
- 4.3. Each party shall use the confidential information only for purposes directly related to this project, and shall not use such confidential information for any other purposes without the prior written approval of the disclosing party;
- 6. Both parties shall cooperate positively with each other and take good measures to achieve the purpose of this agreement;
- 7. The approval of this SSDC street-light project to JICA is not promised at this time. Therefore, if it is rejected, separate consultation. Is required between the parties other than this MOA;

- 8. The parties shall each be solely responsible for any and all troubles and damages and associated with their responsibilities under this MOA;
- 9. The parties shall each be solely responsible for any and all costs associated with their responsibilities under this MOA;
- 10. This MOA may be amended from time to time by mutual agreement of the parties in a written modification signed by both parties;
- 11. This MOA may be terminated by mutual agreement of the parties, and shall automatically terminate upon completion of all responsibilities as stated herein unless otherwise amended.
- 12. In case of any dispute and in order to forestall lengthy and tedious court proceedings, the same shall be resolved first through a committee or arbitration panel to compose in accordance with the supplemental agreement of the parties which shall be a composite part of this agreement.
- This Agreement shall be effective upon signing by the Parties hereto.
