WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated July 07, 2021 from the Office of the City Mayor, requesting for an issuance of a Resolution granting authority to the City Mayor or his representative to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) hereto attached as "ANNEX A" between the City Government of Ormoc and Kabang Kalikasan ng Pilipinas Foundation Inc. (KKPFI);

WHEREAS, in an Opinion dated June 10, 2021, the City Legal Office finds the provisions of the MOU as not contrary to law, public policy, morals, or order, and a copy of the Opinion is hereto attached as "ANNEX B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, KKPFI, is a national organization of the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF), a non-profit organization engaged in the implementation of field projects all over the Philippines in conserving biodiversity and poverty mitigation;

WHEREAS, WWF aims to support the creation of ONE PLANET CITIES (OPC) globally, where people thrive within the ecological limits of our precious planet and WWF-Philippines is locally implementing OPC project with the main goal of assisting Philippines Cities to have the capabilities to implement inclusive climate actions in line with the 1.5C global target and enhanced adaptive and resilient recovery plans;

WHEREAS, ONE PLANET CITY CHALLENGE (OPCC), formerly known as "Earth Hour" City Challenge (EHCC) since its launch in 2011, is an OPC flagship and a biennial, recurring activity that aims to mobilize climate and sustainability actions in cities, while simultaneously providing support for existing actions, in the global transition towards a climate-friendly, one-planet future;

WHEREAS, Participating Philippine cities will gain (1) opportunities to tap into available WWF programs on capacity-building, urban nature-based solutions, transport, waste, food and more, both locally and internationally; (2) collaboration with leading city networks including the Global Covenant of Mayors, ICLEI, C40 and CDP; and (3) city profiling in WWF's public engagement campaign called We Love Cities (WLC) for the declared OPCC finalists;

WHEREAS, LGUs are vested with powers under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to provide ecological balance and general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, LGUs are designated as the frontline agencies to respond to climate change impacts and risks under Republic Act No. 9729, otherwise known as the Climate Change Act of 2009;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc declared its intentions to join OPCC as a new Philippine City Participants to be part of the global challenge for cities that want to take the lead in the necessary climate transition through its submitted Expression of Interest (EOI);

(KKPFI), also known as the World Wide Fund for Nature – Philippines (WWF-Philippines), an organization existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at the 4th Floor, JBD PLAZA, #65 Mindanao Avenue, Brgy. Bagong Pag-asa, Quezon City, represented by its Executive Director, MS. KATHERINE CUSTODIO;

The Ormoc City and KKPFI are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WITNESSETH: That -

WHEREAS KKPFI, a national organization of the World Wide Fund for Nature (the "WWF"), is a non-stock, non-profit organization engaged in the conservation and preservation of the environment in selected areas of the Philippines by helping communities adapt to climate change, switch to clean renewable sources of energy and infuse sustainability into the lives and businesses of Filipinos;

WHEREAS, ORMOC CITY is a local government unit (LGU) and a first-class independent component city in the Philippines, composed of 110 barangays. With the population of 215, 031 based on the 2015 Census, it is the second most-populous city of the province and also considered as the economic, cultural, commercial and transportation hub of Western Leyte.

WHEREAS, ONE PLANET CITY CHALLENGE (OPCC), formerly known as 'Earth Hour Dra@ity Challenge' (EHCC) since its launch in 2011, is an OPC flagship and a biennial, recurring activity that aims to mobilize climate and sustainability actions in cities, while Not simultaneously voicing support for existing actions, in the global transition towards a policy, moral.

Amwhere Asin OPCC opens an opportunity to cities to demonstrate that they have science-based emissions reduction targets that align with a 1.5C future and that these targets are supported by evidence-based climate action planning.

WHEREAS, the participating cities are asked to report the following most important components on the OPCC assessment: (1) targets and commitments; (2) action plans; (3) a greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory; and (4) renewable energy and/or energy efficiency actions on a unified online reporting platform, the same as for the Global Covenant of Mayors (GCoM) with cities reporting on the CDP Cities platform.

WHEREAS, when joining OPCC, cities will receive (1) recognition of achievements on WWF and partners' communications channels; (2) strategic "Feedback Report" with an independent review of your city's climate action plan based on CDP-ICLEI unified reporting system; (3) support in setting science-based targets that reflect the Paris Agreement's goal of limiting climate change to 1.5 °C; and (4) toolbox with guidance on design of a climate action package and educational materials aimed at increasing public participation and involvement

WHEREAS, participating Philippine cities will gain (1) opportunities to tap into available WWF programs on capacity-building, urban nature-based solutions, transport, waste, food and more, both locally and internationally; (2) collaboration with leading city networks including the Global Covenant of Mayors, ICLEI, C40 and CDP and (3) city profiling in WWF's public engagement campaign called We Love Cities (WLC) for the declared OPCC finalists

WHEREAS, LGUs are vested with powers under Republic Act Number 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the 1991, to provide ecological balance and general welfare of its constituents.

WHEREAS, LGUs are designated as the frontline agencies to respond to climate change impacts and risks under Republic Act Number 9729 otherwise known as the Climate Change Act of 2009.

WHEREAS, ORMOC CITY has declared its intention to join OPCC as a new Philippine city participant to be part of the global challenge for cities that want to take the lead in the necessary climate transition through its submitted Expression of Interest (EOI).

WHEREAS, ORMOC CITY and KKPFI share a common objective of supporting projects that directly promote energy efficiency, renewable energy, climate adaptation and conservation that consequently protect the environment and promote sustainable urban development and low-carbon future;

WHEREAS, ORMOC CITY and KKPFI have agreed to work together as partners to spread awareness on the urgency of the climate change crisis, its adverse impacts, and the crucial solutions to address the crisis;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the Parties hereby agree on the following terms and conditions:

ARTICLE II - ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

.1. ORMOC CITY shall:

- a) Work together with KKPFI and its Technical Assistance Provider to create a jointly designed workshop to meet the needs of the city.
- b) Designate their point person whom KKPFI and its Technical Assistance Provider can coordinate, communicate and seek assistance with. Preferably the said point person would have knowledge in information technology and be familiar with any related program for the submission of data online.
- c) Assist KKPFI and its Technical Assistance Provider by providing free and timely access to all necessary and relevant documents, data, and information in relation to the Project.
- d) Attend/Send representatives in any relevant meetings and stakeholders' presentation events (virtual or physical) in relation to the Project.
- e) Provide necessary transportation and/or accommodation for the designated OPCC City Focal Person/s when there is a need to attend relevant meetings and workshops outside Ormoc City.
- Participate in technical webinars and conference calls in relation to the Project.
- g) Willingly report its information and data to the internationally recognized online platform and openly share them to the public.
- h) Assist KKPFI in other OPC potential programs or activities with the city involving other sectors such as youth, academes and in-city business, etc., when requested.
- Organize various IEC activities in support for OPCC's public campaign, if needed.
- such other activities and provide necessary resources deemed necessary in the effective and efficient implementation of this Project.

2. KKPFI shall:
a) Work together with Ormoc City to create a jointly designed workshops to meet the REVIEWED needs of the city.

This MOU shall take effect upon signing hereof by the Parties and shall continue to be in full force and effect until terminated and/or modified by mutual consent of the herein Parties, whichever comes first.

ARTICLE IV - WARRANTIES AND INDEMNITY

- Each of the Parties warrant that each is an entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines and has the power and authority to conduct its business as currently conducted and to consummate the transactions contemplated in this Agreement.
- 2. Each of the Parties warrant that each has the power to execute and deliver, and to perform its obligations under this Agreement, and has taken all necessary corporate and legal action to authorize the execution of this Agreement.
- 3. Each of the Parties warrant that their respective signatories herein are duly authorized to execute this Agreement.
- 4. **KKPFI** warrants that it is authorized by **WWF** to enter into this Agreement and to bind itself insofar as it involves or pertains to **WWF**.
- 5. Each Party shall save and hold the other narmless from and against all liabilities, claims, and demands arising out of any action, omission, negligence or breach of this Agreement.

ARTICLE V - ARBITRATION AND LEGAL ACTION

1. If any agreement should arise from the performance of the obligations on this contract or with regard to any provision thereof, the Parties agree to submit to arbitration or mediation proceedings.

ARTICLE VI - CONFIDENTIALITY

 Either Party shall not disclose to any person, use or reproduce any information concerning the business or affairs of the other, except as may be directly required in the performance of this Agreement. No information shall be passed on to any third party unless otherwise formally agreed upon by both parties.
