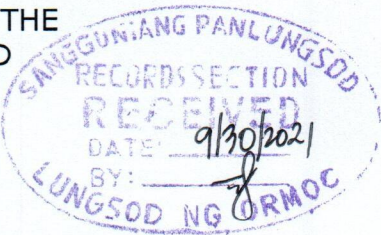

**A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING
ASSISTANCE FROM THE PHILIPPINE CENTER FOR
POST-HARVEST DEVELOPMENT AND MECHANIZATION
(PHILMECH) THRU THE RICE COMPETITIVENESS
ENHANCEMENT FUND-MECHANIZATION COMPONENT.**

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated September 17, 2021 from the Office of the City Mayor, respectfully requesting assistance from the Philippine Center for Post-Harvest Development and Mechanization thru the Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund – Mechanization Component, copy of the Indorsement is hereto attached as "ANNEX A";

WHEREAS, in an Opinion dated September 9, 2021, the City Legal Office finds nothing legally objectionable in the said request and that the same is not contrary to law, morals, public order, or public policy much less detrimental to the best interests of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the Ormoc LGU with address at Aunubing St. Brgy. Cogon, Ormoc City realizes that having control over all aspects of the palay and rice industry is the only way to advance for agricultural development;

WHEREAS, to improve its productivity and save postharvest losses, the Ormoc LGU needed to acquire basic production and postharvest facilities such as;

WHEREAS, the Ormoc LGU has a total more or less of 1,039.23 hectares of irrigated rice land of members;

WHEREAS, the Ormoc LGU has 842 farmer-members that will be directly benefit under the project and has access to the services of expert personnel to manage and operate the said machinery/facilities;

WHEREAS, the proposed location of the project is bounded by rice area with following details:

WHEREAS, the Ormoc LGU has the access in availing/hiring/assigning the following personnel:

- 1. City Agriculturist: Maria Elena E. Mendoza
- 2. Senior Agriculturist: Judith F. Paredes
- 3. Agricultural Engineer: Rico J. Pono
- 4. Operator: Ricardo Corcelles

WHEREAS, the Ormoc LGU has machinery shed as counterpart for the project with an area of 100 sqm:

Location: Agri-Tech Compound, Brgy. San Pablo, Ormoc City, Leyte
Lot Owner: Ormoc LGU

WHEREAS, the Ormoc LGU has available cash for the revolving fund/initial operating cost amounting to Php500,000.00;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, after thorough examination of the aforementioned request, finds that: the same is not contrary to law, existing contract, public policy, customs and morals; is reasonable and in order; the same is entered into for the best interests of the City; and, finally, that the request for assistance, among other lawful purposes, improves the agricultural competency of the City, thus, deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;



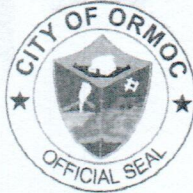

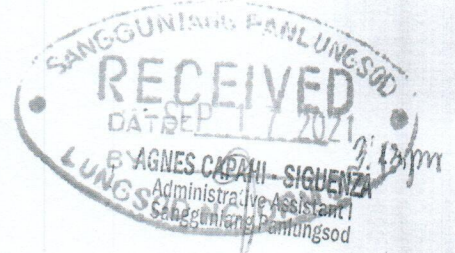
