# RESOLUTION NO. 2021-284

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY SOVERNMENT OF ORMOC TO THE CONVERSION OF LAKE DANAO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL INTO LAKE DANAO INTEGRATED SCHOOL IN BARANGAY LAKE DANAO, ORMOC CITY AND FURTHER EXPRESSING EARNEST COMMITMENT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SAID SCHOOL IN THE NEXT FIVE (5) YEARS OR UNTIL SUCH TIME **FUNDS NEEDED** INCORPORATED IN THE NATIONAL BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of a Local School Board (LSB) Resolution with No. 2021 - 07, entitled: "A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE  $15^{\text{TH}}$ SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD THE CONVERSION OF LAKE DANAO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO LAKE DANAO INTEGRATED SCHOOL AND SECURING THE CONTINUED COMMITMENT AND SUPPORT OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC FOR THE OPERATION OF THE SCHOOL IN THE NEXT FIVE (5) YEARS. Copy of the said resolution is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the conversion of Lake Danao Elementary School into Lake Danao Integrated School in Barangay Lake Danao is driven by the following reasons: (1) to provide an opportunity to those who cannot afford to enroll at the neighboring high schools for their secondary education especially those drop out who wanted to continue their schooling; (2) lessen the financial burden of the poor families in Barangay Lake Danao and its neighboring communities; and (3) to lessen or eliminate the incidence of teenage pregnancy in the said barangay;

WHEREAS, the proposed opening of a high School in Barangay Lake Danao would bring the educational system close to the communities in Barangay Milagro, Barangay Bagong, Barangay Mahayag, and Barangay Hugpa, Ormoc City, and ensure easier access to high school especially among the poor families where drop outs are observed and somehow encourage students to continue their education and eventually decreasing the number of out-of-school youth;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section VI (B.1) of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2014, the proposed establishment of school must be supported by the local government unit through Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution supporting the establishment of school, duly approved by the City Mayor, indicating therein the proposed name of the school;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 40, series of 2014, an action from the Local Government Unit (LGU) must indicate the continued support to provide funds for the operation and maintenance for at least five (5) years or until such time that such funds are incorporated in the national budget;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggurian finds the request not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and the aim is important and beneficial to the people of Ormoc as it promotes better access to education among the youth especially among poor families who would likely have difficulties sending their children to school due to distance so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP member Nolito M. Quilang, Chairman, Committee on Education, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Esteban V. Laurente, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Peter M. Rodriguez, Lalaine A. Marcos, Roiland H. Villasencio and Joan Marbie C. Simbajon; be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC TO THE CONVERSION OF LAKE DANAO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL INTO LAKE DANAO INTEGRATED SCHOOL IN BARANGAY LAKE DANAO, ORMOC CITY AND FURTHER EXPRESSING THE EARNEST COMMITMENT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SAID SCHOOL IN THE NEXT FIVE (5) YEARS OR UNTIL SUCH TIME FUNDS NEEDED ARE INCORPORATED IN THE NATIONAL BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION;

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-07**

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE 15<sup>TH</sup> SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD THE CONVERSION OF LAKE DANAO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO LAKE DANAO INTEGRATED SCHOOL AND SECURING THE CONTINUED COMMITMENT AND SUPPORT OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC FOR THE OPERATION OF THE SCHOOL IN THE NEXT FIVE (5) YEARS;

WHEREAS, during the Local School Board meeting on May 19, 2021, the School Principal of Lake Danao Elementary School together with the Schools District Supervisor Melissa Bughao presented the proposal to convert Lake Danao Elementary School to Lake Danao Integrated School;

WHEREAS, according to the feasibility study conducted by the school principal, the school has a projected enrollment of 44 incoming Grade 7 students since Lake Danao Elementary School has currently 41 Grade 6 learners and there are 3 residents of Brgy. Lake Danao studying in Milagro Elementary School therefore meeting the required minimum number of potential enrollees in establishing an integrated school which is 30 or more;

WHEREAS, establishing an integrated school in Brgy. Danao aims to provide an opportunity—to those who cannot afford to enroll at the nearest national high schools— to pursue their secondary education; (2) to lessen the financial burden of the families in Brgy. Danao and its neighboring communities; and (3) to lessen/eliminate the case of teenage pregnancy and insurgency in the said barangay;

WHEREAS, the proposed integrated school is also accessible to neighboring barangays including Milagro, Bagong, Mahayag and Hugpa, Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the teaching force and the General Parent Teachers Association of Lake Danao Elementary School in coordination of the Sangguniang Barangay of Danao, Ormoc City expresses their full support for the said conversion by passing Barangay Resolution No. 16 series of 2021;

WHEREAS, the proposed conversion of Lake Danao Elementary School to Lake Danao Integrated School also needs support from the Local Government Unit through a Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution and certification where the Local Government Unit of Ormoc shall continue to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of the said school in the next five (5) years or until such time that the needed funds for the foregoing are already provided in the national budget as stipulated in the DepEd Order No. 40 series of 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the motion of SDS Lani Cervantes, jointly seconded by Mr. Codog and Mr. Cesar Garcia., with no objection from the members, and approved by the presiding officer, be it:
