## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-367

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR RICHARD 1. GOMEZ, OR ACTING CITY MAYOR, OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE, THE RELEASE OF CASH ASSISTANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED **THOUSAND** PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP500,000.00) EACH TO THE FOLLOWING FIVE (5) LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE COVERED DECLARATION OF STATE OF CALAMITY, NAMELY: OF MUNICIPALITY BATO, MUNICIPALITY HILONGOS, **MUNICIPALITY** OF HINDANG, MUNICIPALITY OF INOPACAN, AND MUNICIPALITY OF MATALOM; FOR A TOTAL OF TWO MILLION AND FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP 2,500,000.00), SAID FUNDS TO BE TAKEN FROM THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (LDRRM) **FUND** 2021 (QUICK RESPONSE FUND).

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated December 29, 2021 from the Office of the City Mayor requesting for the passage of a Resolution authorizing the release of cash assistance of Five Hundred Thousand Philippine Pesos (Php500,000.00) each for the above-mentioned severely affected LGUs of Southern Leyte, a copy of the Indorsement is hereto attached and is made an integral part hereof;



WHEREAS, on December 28, 2021, a Full Council Meeting of the Ormoc City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management was convened and identified five (5) severely affected Municipalities of Southern Leyte, namely: 1. Municipality of Bato; 2. Municipality of Hilongos; 3. Municipality of Hindang; 4. Municipality of Inopacan and; 5. Municipality of Matalom;

WHEREAS, last 16 to 19 December 2021, Typhoon Odette (international code name: Rai) caused widespread devastation and massive damage to houses, infrastructure, properties, and agriculture, and resulted in the disruption of critical lifelines of Filipinos in areas affected by the said typhoon;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 1267 of 2021 declares a State of Calamity to Region IV-B (MIMAROPA), VI (Western Visayas), VII (Central Visayas), VIII (Eastern Visayas), X (Northern Mindanao) and XIII (CARAGA) to hasten the rescue, relief, and rehabilitation efforts of the government and the private sector, including any humanitarian assistance;

WHEREAS, Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 2021-683, a Resolution declaring the entire province of Leyte under the State of Calamity due to Typhoon "ODETTE";

WHEREAS, Sec 21 of RA 10121 or the PDRRM Act of 2010 and its Implementing Rules (Rule 18, Section 1) states that... "upon the recommendation of the LDRRMO and approval of the Sanggunian concerned, the LDRRM Council may transfer funds (LDRRMF) to support disaster risk reduction work of other LDRRMCs which are declared under state of calamity" for relief and recovery programs in order that situation and living conditions of people in communities or areas stricken by disasters, calamities, epidemics, or complex emergencies, may be normalized as quickly as possible;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc has also been a recipient of various assistance from generous donors during the time when it was also in dire situations and as a way of paying it forward, manifested its desire to extend financial assistance to these severely affected LGUs;

WHEREFORE, on MASS MOTION of the Body; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ, OR ACTING CITY MAYOR, OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE, THE RELEASE OF CASH ASSISTANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (Php500,000.00) EACH TO THE FOLLOWING FIVE (5) LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE COVERED BY THE DECLARATION OF STATE OF CALAMITY, NAMELY: MUNICIPALITY OF BATO, MUNICIPALITY OF HILONGOS, MUNICIPALITY OF HINDANG, MUNICIPALITY OF INOPACAN, AND MUNICIPALITY OF MATALOM; FOR A TOTAL OF TWO MILLION AND FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP 2,500,000.00), SAID FUNDS TO BE TAKEN FROM THE 5% LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (LDRRM) FUND 2021 (QUICK RESPONSE FUND);


