A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO CITY MAYOR RICHARD I GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) **BETWEEN** THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC AND THE ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF "FROJECT"-CONSTRUCTION OF EVACUATION CENTER AT THE CAMP **DOWNES MILITARY** RESERVATION.

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of and Indorsement dated February 04, 2022 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of a Resolution granting authority to the City Mayor or his representative to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Armed Forces of the Philippines, for the implementation of the "PROJECT" - construction of Evacuation Center at the Camp Downes Military Reservation. Further requesting that this matter be treated as EXTREMELY URGENT, copy of the MOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code states, that "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants";

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Republic Act 10121 or the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 mandates the organization of Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils for it to "ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs, and budgets as strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction" and "recommend the implementation of forced or preemptive evacuation of local residents if necessary;

WHEREAS, the construction and maintenance by the City of evacuation centers are necessary to provide immediate relief and shelter to residents whose safety and security are threatened and are in imminent danger due to calamity of whatever nature and cause;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Camp Downes has issued a Resolution No. 4, series of 2022 and requesting the City Mayor to allocate funds for the construction of an evacuation center;

WHEREAS, an evacuation in Barangay Camp Downes (hereinafter referred to as the "PROJECT") is deemed a strategic location for responders and frontliners to efficiently respond to emergencies;

WHEREAS, the funds for the construction of an evacuation center in Barangay Camp Downes will be considered out of the City's appropriations for the Fiscal Year 2022;

WHEREAS, the proposed location for the evacuation center in Barangay Camp Downes is within the premises of a military reservation as determined by Proclamation No. 502 signed by President Ferdinand E. Marcos on December 23, 1968;

WHEREAS the subject MOA clearly and plainly encapsulates the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and obligations towards the attainment of the lofty ends of the same, and this Sanggunian, upon thorough review, finds that the same is entered to promote people's interest, thereby, serving the best interests of the City and its constituents, and therefore, is most deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;

WHEREAS, the proposed location for the evacuation center in Barangay Camp Downes is within the premises of a military reservation as determined by Proclamation No. 502 signed by President Ferdinand E. Marcos on December 23, 1968;

WHEREAS, the parties herein agree that the evacuation center will be beneficial to the residents of Barangay Camp Downes, the whole of Ormoc and the officers and personnel of the SECOND PARTY;

WMEREAS, the parties herein further agree that the structures of the evacuation center will remain as property of the CITY but will be subject to use by the SECOND PARTY;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the terms and conditions set forth, the parties herein agree as follows:

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- and relevant laws, rules, regulations, and issuances of appropriate government offices;
- 4. Implement and provide construction management and supervision;
- 5. Facilitate/process the application of necessary permits and clearances necessary for the implementation of the PROJECT;
- 6. In accordance with accounting principles, provide and undertake the necessary maintenance of the evacuation center;
- 7. Prohibit the storage of hazardous, highly flammable, or illegal goods or materials in the evacuation center; and
- 8. Manage, operate, utilize or appropriate the evacuation center and allow the SECOND PARTY to jointly use the same.

C. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY:

- 1. Provide an area for PROJECT and the CITY's temporary field office within the project site for the duration of the PROJECT;
- 2. Allow entry to the evacuation center by CITY representatives and all users of the evacuation center.
- 3. Designate a focal person who will act on its behalf, on matters relative to the PROJECT and the use of the evacuation center; and
- 4. Use the evacuation center, in coordination with the FIRST PARTY and/or the representatives of Barangay Camp Downes;

D. REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS

- 1. The FIRST PARTY shall not introduce additional improvement/s or extension/s on the premises without prior written notice to and express approval of the SECOND PARTY; and
- 2. Any fixed and immovable construction/improvements on the premises shall be retained in favor of the SECOND PARTY, without any cost, once this Agreement is terminated.
