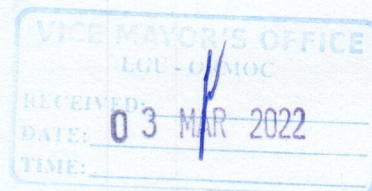
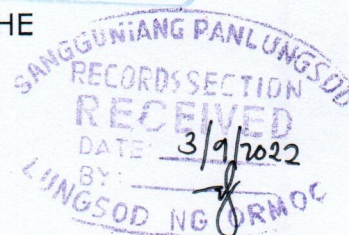

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-051

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT BARANGAY
ORDINANCE NO. 002 SERIES OF 2021 OF BRGY.
LINAO, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING
PET ANIMALS TO STRAY IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE
STREETS, OPEN SPACE AND COVERED COURT,
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES" UNDER REVIEW HAS
BEEN FOUND TO BE IN CONFORMITY WITH EXISTING
LAWS AND ORDINANCES, AND INTERPOSING NO
OBJECTION TO ITS IMPLEMENTATION**

WHEREAS, the Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received copy of an Ordinance from Barangay Linao, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PET ANIMALS TO STRAY IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE STREETS, OPEN SPACE AND COVERED COURT, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES". The copy of the Ordinance together with its attachments are hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the ordinance was submitted to this Sanggunian pursuant to its review powers over enacted ordinances of all barangays within its territory as provided for in Section 57 and 458 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" (LGC) in order to find out whether the subject Ordinances approved by the respective Sangguniang Barangays are within the scope of its prescribed powers and also whether the same are in conformity with law and city ordinances;

WHEREAS, the ordinance seeks to address wide-spread of rabies and foul odor due to wastes and garbage causes by stray dogs and cats in public places in the interest of public safety and health and to promote responsible pet ownership;

WHEREAS, to address the issue, measures are implemented to reduce injuries and deaths caused by the same;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian, finally finds that the Ordinance, subject to the recommendations of the Joint Committee, is valid and lawful and within the scope and authority of the Barangay, and therefore, manifests herein no objections to its implementation, and even urges that they be implemented immediately in order to speedily further the noble ends they seek for the welfare of the Barangay;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances and SP Member Tomas R. Serafica, Chairman, Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries, and Agrarian Reform, severally seconded by SP Members Roiland H. Villasencio, Nolito M. Quilang, Eusebio Gerardo S. Pensergera, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lalaine A. Marcos, Esteban V. Laurente, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon and Jasper M. Lucero; be it



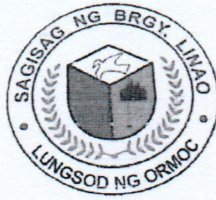

BARANGAY ORDINANCE No. 002 Series of 2021

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PET ANIMALS TO STRAY IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE STREETS, OPEN SPACE AND COVERED COURT, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, the Barangay Liniao is presently confronted with a serious problem about stray animals particularly DOGS and CATS wandering and roaming around the barangay, posing danger to the public brought about by incidental bites and befouling neighborhood with their waste and garbage. *scattering*

WHEREAS, to prevent the wide-spread of rabies and foul odor of waste and garbage by stray animals; *scattering of garbage*

WHEREAS, this Barangay Ordinance No. 002 seeks to address wide-spread of rabies and foul odor due to wastes and garbage caused by stray dogs and cats in public places in the interest for public safety and health and to promote responsible pet ownership;

WHEREAS, on motion by Hon. SBM. Flordeliza E. Navarrete and duly seconded by all SBM present, be it

ORDAINED, by the Council of Barangay Liniao, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. REGISTRATION AND OWENERSHIP


- (a.) All barangay Linao residents who are pet owners, custodian, keepers and possessors of animals categorically related and/or scientifically related to the family of dogs (Kennels) and cats (Feline) shall register the said domesticated pets in the Barangay Hall of Barangay Linao to commence on the first regular working day of January and will end until the last working day of February on the year 2022.
- (b.) Upon registration of the animal possessions, a process of vaccination immediately follows. A pet tag is assigned to the pet owner that bears the respective serial number of each domesticated pet to serve as its identification tab for reference of their health and record of vaccination.
- (c.) A fee of One hundred Pesos (⁵⁰~~100.00~~ php.) shall be collected from the pet owner/keeper for every pet tag issued; in case of lost, the same amount shall be paid for the replacement thereof.
- (d.) The pet owner or keeper of the registered animal/s shall ensure that the pet tag is worn at all times by their pet animal/s.
- (e.) It shall be unlawful for any person or institution to keep an unregistered, unvaccinated and unsecured dog and cat within their territorial domain. All pet dogs three (3) months old and above and pet cats shall be registered and vaccinated. Dog and cat vaccination will be administered by the City Veterinarians personnel that it will be feasible, convenient and safe to all concerned. After the vaccination, pet owners will be provided by a certificate as proof of compliance.
- (f.) The pet owner who fails to register within the period as prescribed in Section 1 hereof shall be penalized by a fine of Two Hundred Pesos (200.00 php.) payable within five (5) calendar days from notice hereof.

SECTION 2. LEASHING AND OTHER PROPER KEEPING OF PET ANIMALS-

- (a.) Pet animals shall be kept and nurtured within the premises of the residence or establishment. In addition, owners of potentially vicious dogs shall signify a printed words prominently displayed in front of the premises/residence.
- (b.) Potentially vicious Dogs can be brought for a walk by the owner/keeper outside of the premises of the residence or establishment provided that a protective muzzle shall cover the mouth and the said animal shall be held securely on a leash not exceeding 2 meters in length.

SECTION 3. IMPOUNDING, ADOPTION AND DISPOSAL OF STRAY ANIMALS

- (a.) Dog and cat that are found outside the premises of the owner are considered stray animals. Stray animals are immediately secured for impounding.
- (b.) An impounding fee of One Hundred Pesos (100.00 php.) per day per animal shall be collected by the Barangay treasurer from the claimant.
- (c.) Impounded stray animals which are not claimed by the owner/s within three (3) days will be turned-over to the City Veterinarian's office for proper care and action.
- (d.) It is encouraged to pet owners who can no longer give appropriate care and management to donate, sell or dispose to another person willing to comply the responsibilities being a pet owner.
- (e.) The Punong Barangay, Sanggunian Barangay Members or any person in authority designated for this purpose shall not be held accountable for any liability thereof.



SECTION 4. BARANGAY STRAY ANIMALS POUND/SHELTER

- (a.) The barangay shall construct a safe and clean pound for stray animals taken from the barangay fund.
- (b.) The maintenance of the pound shall be taken from the fine/penalty paid by the pet owner.
- (c.) Stray animal-control personnel/s shall be designated by the Punong Barangay with responsibility of responding to call for service by the person concerned.

SECTION 5. AGENCIES/OFFICES TO ENFORCE AND IMPLEMENT THIS ORDINANCE-

- (a.) The Punong Barangay, Sanggunian Barangay Members, Barangay Tanods, Barangay Health Workers, City Veterinarian Office, and the Police Station No. 4 of Barangay Linao shall give their full- support in its implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance hereof.

SECTION 6. BARANGAY SHARES ON PROCEEDS OF FEES AND FINES- The barangay is entitled to fifty percent (50%) share on all fees and fines collected within their jurisdiction.

SECTION 7. LIABILITY OF PET OWNER TO POTENTIALLY VICIOUS ANIMALS

- (a.) Pet owner or any person or entity in possession shall be civilly liable for any injury, damage or harm caused to another person.
- (b.) The pet owner of duly registered animals shall be responsible for the cleanliness and sanitation prescribed for proper handling. The pet owner shall clean/remove any forms of waste matters emanating from their pets that may cause to litter the street and vicinity of the barangay. Failure to clean/remove such will constitute the corresponding penalty prescribed in Section 8 hereof.


SECTION 8. PENALTIES- Any person or entity found guilty of violating any of the provision of this Ordinance shall be subject for penalty as follows:

- 150 ADMN CNO C/ST/ST
200 FINE
- (a.) Fine of not less than Two Hundred (200.00 php.) but not more than Four Hundred (400.00 php.) on the **first offense**.
 - (b.) Fine of not less than Three Hundred (300.00 php.) but not more than Five Hundred (500.00 php.) on the **second offense**.
 - 300 (c.) Fine of not less than Five Hundred (500.00 php.) but not more than One Thousand (1000.00 php.) on the **third offense**.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE- If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is withheld, other provision or parts thereof not declared as such shall remain valid and enforceable.


SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE- Ordinances, Resolutions, and other issuances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY- This Ordinance shall take effect immediately in compliance with the provision of Section 59 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.
