A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE THE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE PHILIPPINE COUNCIL FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES (PCAF), FOR THE DOWNLOADING OF OPERATIONAL FUNDS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2022 IN AMOUNT OF **FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND** PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP48,000.00) IN SUPPORT FOR THE CONDUCT OF CONSULTATIVE MEETING FOR THE INDEPENDENT COMPONENT CITY FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERY COUNCIL (ICCAFC) OF ORMOC CITY

WHEREAS, the 15TH Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received an endorsement letter from the Office of the City Mayor on February 22, 2022 for consideration of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-ORMOC) and the Philippine Council for Agriculture and Fisheries (PCAF), represented by its OIC Executive Director, LIZA G. BATTAD, Ph.D., a copy of the MOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the PCAF under Executive Order No. 366, Series of 2004 assumes strengthened functions related to coordination and monitoring of agriculture and fisheries modernization processes, and development of public-private partnerships as consultative bodies to the Department of Agriculture (DA);

WHEREAS, for the development of public and private partnerships, PCAF shall provide technical leadership, guidance and support for the continued development of the nationwide network of Agricultural and Fishery Councils (AFCs);

WHEREAS, the PCAF shall provide technical and financial support in the consultation, monitoring, and membership validation activities of the AFCs as well as logistical support funds to the AFC Office to effectively and efficiently carry out its activities in the whole region;

WHEREAS, the PCAF has adopted the Policy Service Ambassadorship System (PSAS) under its Innovative Consultation for Agriculture and Fishery Policy Reform and Engagement (iCARE) Program as a client-oriented strategy aimed at ensuring the interface of the different AFC policy-making processes towards achieving the planned activities and attainment of its targets:

WHEREAS, the LGU-ORMOC shall oversee the implementation of the various programs/projects/ activities of the AFCs and shall likewise provide technical assistance, consultation, integration, networking, monitoring and advocacy in the local communities to ensure the attainment of its thrusts and mandates as well as contribute to the twin goals, *Masaganang Ani at Mataas na Kita* of the DA;

WHEREAS, CY 2022 PCAF budget provides funds for AFC operations and PCAF is authorized to release said funds to the AFCs as donations and representation expense through the Department of Agriculture-Regional Field Offices and other authorized conduits;

WHEREAS, PCAF shall allocate, obligate and release to the City Agriculture Office (CAO), this City, the amount of FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP48,000.00) as CY 2022 operational funds for the AFC operations and consultations;

WHEREAS, after review of the draft MOA by the City Legal Officer of the City she finds nothing legally objectionable therein considering that the same is in order, not contrary to law, morals or public policy;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the aforementioned MOA is advantageous and for the best interest of the City, especially the farmers, fisher folks and to the community as a whole;

Laurente, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon, Peter M. Rodriguez and Roiland H. Villasencio; be it

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY coordinates with the provincial and municipal agricultural offices and other government and non-government organizations (NGOs) in the implementation of the different AFC programs/projects and activities;

WHEREAS, the C.Y. 2022 budget of the **FIRST PARTY** provides funds for AFC operations and it is authorized to release said funds to the AFCs through the DA-RFOs and other fund conduits;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing covenants and stipulations, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. The **FIRST PARTY** shall:

a. Allot, obligate and release to CITY ACRICULTURE OFFICE the amount of FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (F48,000.00) as POLICY SERVICE AMBASSADORSHIP FUND in support of the AFC activities following the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The funds shall be used and recorded for purposes and account code as stated below:

- b. Reserve the right to intervene and institute measures in case of, but not limited to, misuse of the fund and non-compliance with the provisions stipulated in this agreement; and
- c Periodically monitor the utilization of fund releases and the submission of physical and financial AFC accomplishment reports.

- e. Submit to the **FIRST PARTY** disbursement/liquidation reports (Annex B) as received by the Office of the Resident Auditor as well as the expected outputs for the activities as stated in the above matrix; and
- f. Refund to the FIRST PARTY any unused fund ending December 31, 2022.
- III. In the event the **SECOND PARTY** fails to submit the expected outputs of previous release for AFC activities, subsequent release for the same purpose shall be held by the **FIRST PARTY** pending the submission of the required outputs. If no disbursement reports are submitted at all, the SECOND PARTY shall return the whole amount to the **FIRST PARTY**.
