**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ANNUAL WORK
PROGRAM FOR THE YEAR 2022 OF COVID-19
RELATED PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS
(PAPs) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE ENERGY
REGULATION (ER) 1-94 FUNDS PURSUANT TO
THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY CIRCULAR NO.
DC2020-04-00080**

WHEREAS, there is an endorsement letter from the OIC- City Mayor Atty. Nolito M. Quilang, dated March 17, 2022, respectfully endorsing to the office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the herein Annual Work Program for the year 2022 of COVID-19 related PAPs to be funded from the City's share of ER 1-94 Funds and requesting for the passage of resolution approving the same;

WHEREAS, RA 7638 (otherwise known as the Department of Energy Act of 1992), mandates the DOE to devise ways and means of giving direct benefits to the province, city, or municipality, especially the community and people affected, and equitable preferential benefit to the city that hosts the energy resource and/or the energy-generating facility;

WHEREAS, DOE promulgated Energy Regulation No. 1-94 (ER 1-94) on August 1, 1994 to operationalize the implementation of Section 5 of Republic Act No. 7638, which regulation provides for the nature and scope of benefits for the affected community, the people affected, and the pertinent host local government unit (LGU) shall be entitled to from the energy resource developer or power producer;

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Article II of the Philippine Constitution sets forth the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people;

WHEREAS, the President issued Proclamation No. 929 Declaring A State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to the COVID-19, enjoining all government agencies and Local Government Unit (LGUs) to render full assistance to and cooperation with each other, and mobilizing the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent, and appropriate disaster response aid and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, as a response, the DOE issued Department Order (DO) Circular No. 2020-04-00080 entitled "Rationalizing the Utilization of ER 1-94 Funds by Host Local Government Units in Response to COVID-19 Public Health Emergency" which took effect last April 6, 2020 stating that Host LGUs can now use these funds to undertake their duty to mitigate, if not, contain COVID-19, and issuing the corresponding framework to utilize ER 1-94 Funds to bolster their efforts to the COVID-19 crisis in their respective areas;

WHEREAS, the LGU has an available ER 1-94 Fund amounting to Four Million Philippine Pesos (Php4,000,000) which, as per the Annual Work Program herein attached as Annex "A," is to be spent for the City Health Department efforts for Contact Tracers used for database and information purposes, for Covid-19 patients confined at the Ormoc City LIGTAS Covid Center, for vaccination purposes and other essential COVID-19 Health Programs;

WHEREAS, the Annual Work Program (AWP) for the year 2022 for the COVID-19 related PAPs is justified, meritorious and deemed reasonable, and is in line with the thrust of our Local Government to contain the spread of COVID-19, hence, most deserving of prompt favorable action;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Lalaine A. Marcos, Chairperson, Committee on Environment, Natural Resources, and Energy Conservation, and SP Member Peter M. Rodriguez, Chairperson Committee on Finance and Appropriation, severally seconded by SP Members Roiland H. Villasencio, Nolito M. Quilang, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Esteban V. Laurente and Joan Marbie C. Simbajon; be it




