Any such amount still not fully utilized after five years shall revert back to the General Fund and will be available for the services to be identified by the local Sanggunian;

WHEREAS, COA Circular No. 2012-002 dated September 12, 2012 (Section 4.4), the LDRRMC's shall decide the use of the unexpended balance of the LDRRMF which shall be incorporated in the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund Investment Plan (LDRRMFIP);

WHEREAS, the Trust Fund-LDRRMF 2022 Budget Program and Investment Plan has undergone a budget plan review by the City Planning and Development Office, City Budget Office, and Office of the City Accountant;

WHEREAS, the resolution issued is within the powers of the CDRRMC and is reflective of the programs and projects of the LGU and in consonance to budgetary provisions based on the foundation on disaster preparedness, prevention and mitigation;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian finds that the request is meritorious, reasonable and is geared towards good governance and administration and not contrary to existing accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations;
