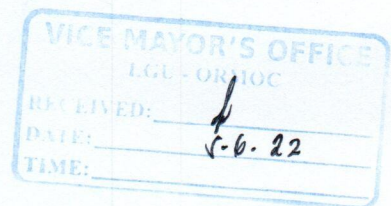
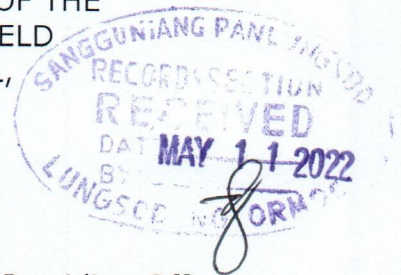

AGREEMENT (LOA) BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT
OF ORMOC AND THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES
LOS BAÑOS - COLLEGE OF HUMAN ECOLOGY IN
SUPPORT FOR THE CITY'S REQUEST FOR TECHNICAL
ASSISTANCE IN UPDATING THE CITY DISASTER RISK
REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN (TERM PLAN)
2021-2026**

WHEREAS, this Fifteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated April 21, 2022 from the Office of the City Mayor, endorsing a request for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor or Acting City Mayor the authority to sign the Letter of Agreement (LOA) between the City Government of Ormoc and the University of the Philippines Los Baños - College of Human Ecology in support for the city's request for technical assistance in updating the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (term plan) 2021-2026, a copy of the LOA is hereto attached as "ANNEX A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in an Opinion dated April 8, 2022, the City Legal Office finds nothing legally objectionable in the said LOA and that the same is not contrary to law, morals, public order, or public policy much less detrimental to the best interests of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, University of the Philippines Los Baños - College of Human Ecology agrees to jointly formulate the City's Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan within its Technical Assistance Program on Human Settlements Planning (TAP-HSP);

WHEREAS, a methodical report shall be provided both in hard and electronic copies detailing Ormoc City's ecological and risk profile, as well as, comprehensive analysis on the initiatives and responses on four Disaster Risk Reduction and Management thematic areas in Disaster Prevention and Mitigation, Disaster Preparedness, Disaster Response, and Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery;

WHEREAS, the City Government, on its part, welcomes the technical assistance of the University through its research and latest developments, thus, harnessing the City's competency and capability in disaster preparedness;

WHEREAS, the subject LOA clearly and plainly encapsulates the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and obligations towards the attainment of the lofty ends of the same, and this Sanggunian, upon thorough review, finds that the same is entered for the purpose of harnessing the City's disaster preparedness through collaborative research, thereby, serving the best interests of the City and its constituents, and therefore, is most deserving of this august Body's prompt and favorable consideration;


ADOPTED, May 05, 2022.

Dear Mayor Gomez:

This is to confirm our agreement to engage the services of the Department of Community and Environmental Resource Planning (DCERP) of the College of Human Ecology (CHE) through its Practicum Students, within its Technical Assistance Program on Human Settlements Planning (TAP-HSP), related to the conduct of the above-referenced project.

1. DCERP-CHE and the LGU of Ormoc City hereby agree to the responsibilities and the rules for carrying out the services required by the project as set forth below.
2. DCERP-CHE shall deploy five Practicum Students under HUME 200a (Supervised Field Experience) for the formulation of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan for Ormoc City, Leyte from April 25 to June 9, 2022.
3. DCERP-CHE shall ensure the completion of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan for Ormoc City, Leyte as well as the submission of outputs in hard and electronic copy by July 2022.
4. DCERP-CHE shall assign at least two (2) Faculty Supervisors who shall:
 - a. Have direct supervision of the students;
 - b. Review the draft output presentation of the Practicum students;
 - c. Provide technical guidance in the conduct of data collection, data analysis, report preparation and presentation; and
 - d. Review and provide comments on the draft reports prior to the preparation of the final report.

5. The Practicum Team shall prepare a report on the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan for Ormoc City, Leyte. The team's specific tasks include:
- To review and update the ecological profile of Ormoc City;
 - To identify the risk profile of Ormoc City;
 - To analyze the current situation, initiatives, responses and gaps in responses of Ormoc City based on four DRRM thematic areas such as Disaster Prevention and Mitigation, Disaster Preparedness, Disaster Response, and Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery.
