

(3) The film company must keep the "curious public" at a minimum distance of ten (10) meters from the camera or crew which may be going about their business. If necessary and available, a member of the Police Force of the City shall be assigned by the Chief of Police to maintain order.

SECTION 4.1.8.4. Penalty. -- Any film company that shall violate the provisions of this article shall have his permit revoked immediately without refund of whatever fees that may have been advanced. He shall suffer an additional fine of one hundred pesos (P100.00) destierro upon recommendation of the proper court.

Article 15 -- Water Service and Conditions of Installation

SECTION 4.1.9.1. Rates of Payment. -- All rates of payment in connection with services of the Ormoc City Waterworks System are hereby fixed in the following manner provided hereunder:

1. Metered rates:
 - a. Domestic P 0.50/ cu.m.
 - b. Commercial75/ cu.m.
 - c. Special Service (water delivered to receptacles, boats, barges, water tanks, etc.) 5.00/ cu.m.
2. Flat Rates:
 - a. Domestic 60.00/month (min)
 - b. Commercial 150.00/month (min)
3. Minimum:
 - a. Domestic 7.50/mon. for cu.m.
 - b. Commercial 15.00/month for cu.m.
 - c. Special Service 25.00 for 5 cu.m.
4. Deposit:
 - a. for 1/2" diam. pipe 50.00
 - b. for 3/4" diam. pipe 100.00
 - c. for 1" diam. pipe 200.00
5. Installation Fee:
 - a. for 1/2" diam. pipe 50.00
 - b. for 3/4" diam. pipe 100.00
 - c. for 1" diam. pipe 200.00
6. Reopening Fee:
 - a. for 1/2" diam. pipe 10.00
 - b. for 3/4" diam. pipe 20.00
 - c. for 1" diam. pipe 40.00

SECTION 4.1.9.2. Exemption. -- Any owner of land traversed by pipes of the system, or the owner of the land where the source of water comes from, shall be allowed a minimum of FREE CONSUMPTION water not exceeding thirty (30) cubic meters per month, and that excess of the same, the said owners of the land shall be charged P0.50 per cubic meter for domestic use and P0.75 per cubic meter commercial use.

SECTION 4.1.9.3. Time of Payment. -- Payment of the consumption of water shall be made at the office of the Waterworks Superintendent within ten (10) days of the succeeding month. Installation and reopening fees are payable in advance.

SECTION 4.1.9.4. Accrual of Fees. -- Starting January 1, 1977-December 31, 1987, revenues collected by the Ormoc Waterworks System after deducting cost of operation and improvements, shall accrue to a special trust fund which shall only be exclusively used for the continuing improvement program of the system and its future extensions to newly urbanized areas of the City of Ormoc.

SECTION 41.9.5. Penalty for delinquency. - Non-payment of water bills for a period of six (6) months shall be sufficient cause of disconnection of water pipes to the customer, without prejudice to the collection of the unpaid obligation plus interest of twelve (12) per centum per annum until the amount is fully paid.

TITLE V FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 5.0.0.1. Explanatory Clause. - Whenever a provision requires that an official of the City Government shall be responsible for issuing permits and providing rules therein, and such government official has not been appointed, nor has his item been created by the Sangguniang Bayan, it shall devolve upon the Office of the Mayor to furnish the services provided herein.

SECTION 5.0.0.2. Administrative Authority of the City Treasurer. The City Treasurer shall formulate forms and issue such regulations as may be needed from time to time for the proper, effective and efficient implementation of this Code.

SECTION 5.0.0.3. Issuance and Revocation of Permits and Licenses. The issuance and revocation of permits and licenses must not be unjust, oppressive, discriminatory, or in restraint of trade.

SECTION 5.0.0.4. Repealing Clause. - All ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, which are inconsistent with any provision or provisions of this Code are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5.0.0.5. Accrual to the General Fund. - Unless otherwise provided by law or ordinances, fines, costs, forfeitures and pecuniary liabilities imposed by the courts for violation of any ordinance shall accrue to the General Fund.

SECTION 5.0.0.6. Severability Clause. - Should any provision, section or part of this Code be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect nor impair the remaining provision, sections or parts which provisions, sections or parts shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 5.0.0.7. Effectivity. - This Code shall take effect on
