RESOLUTION NO. 813

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, on motion of Rigawad Bestabella, seconded by Kagawad Samson;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND THE MUST THE NULL SERVICES OF ORMOC CITY, PRESU TRING FEAS AND RAWALS THERE-FOR, AND FOR ITS PROPER AND EFFECTIVE ADMINISTRATION

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng rmoc, That:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Ormoc City Bus Terminal Services Ordinance."

SECTION 2 Venue. The Bus Terminal Services as provided for in the preceding station shall have its place of business and be housed in the nelly converced terminal building built for the purpose and within its timediate vicinity as may be defined.

SECTION . Definition of terms. - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following are hereby defined:

- (a) Services shall mean to include all the facilities in the terwinal that could be afforded and would inure to the benefit of the
- (b) Terminal means the area or place where in-coming public utility conveyances could discharge or disembark their passengers and ould likewise solicit passengers for their respective destinations.
- (c) Dispatcher means any person employed by the operator of a bus or jeepney to solicit passengers for a given public conveyance.
- (d) Operator means a person who is a holder of a certificate of public convenience to conduct the business of transporting passengers within a given line or route.
- (e) Major repairs means those repairs which require a period of not less than three (3) hours time for their accomplishments.
- (f) Carage means a building or compartment of a building used for housing an automotive vehicle; a repair shop for automotive vehicles.
- (g) Overnight parking shall mean to be the parking of a vehicle in the premises of the terminal from the early hours of the evening until and up to anytime past twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight.

SECTION 4. Fees and rentals or contracts. - There shall be levied upon and imposed on every passenger bus or jeepney a terminal fee and/or rental, as the case may be, for services rendered and facilities offered for parking or leading purposes, which shall be paid to the City Treasurer or his duly authorized representative according to their respective categories as follows:

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That should a contract be necessary with any interested person, bus or jeepney operator, or if a contractual relation—ship for the use of the premises is deemed more convenient for both parties rather than the imposition of fees prescribed herein, they such a relationship shall be entered into: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the basic rental shall not be less than three thousand pesos (P3,000) per month per bay but in no case shall the mode terminal be awarded to a single operator: PROVIDED, FURTHERMOTA, that the contract or covenant shall be entered into and/or signed by the city haver under such terms and conditions as he may deem appropriate; and PNOVIDED, FINALLY, That in no case shall the precises by converted into a garage for vehicles and neither shall major repairs be undertaken thereat. SECTION 5. Employment of dispatchers: band required. - Operators

SECTION 5. Employment of dispatchers: hand required. - Operators of passenger buses or jeep ne's may be allowed or permitted to employ dispatchers: PROVIDED, That dispatchers as employed shall have to be bonded in the amount of not less than one thousand pesos (P1,000.00), cash or property bond, the same being answerable to whatever loss or losses that any passenger may suffer in the course of handling of such cargo or var oet and/or exfects by the dispatchers concerned, properly identified by verying their respective uniforms and nameplates and in no case shall any person be employed as such if he or she has been convicted of a crive involving moral turpitude and, for this purpose, police and court clearness shall have to be secured before his or her employment at dispatcher by any given bus or jeepney company or operator. The accessary permit, however, shall have to be secured from the Office of the City Mayor before any dispatcher could exercise such privilege within the City of Ormoc.

SECTION 7. Conduct and behavior of dispatchers. - Utmost courtesy and honesty shall be accorded to all and every passenger by the dispatchers and in no case shall roughness and discourteous conduct be made.

SECTION 8. Prohibition to solicit or accept passengers outside the terminal premises: exception. - It shall be prohibited and be considered as a violation of this Ordinance for a passenger bus or jeepney driver, conductor, dispatcher, or any other person authorized or not by any operator or his representative to solicit or accept passengers and allow them to board their bus or jeepney in any place of the poblacion of Ormoc City other than the bus terminal area heretofore designated, except the picking up of passengers while on their way out of the Poblacion or in the course of their route towards their respective destinations.

SECTION 9. Penalty. - Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance by any driver, conductor, dispatcher and/or any representative of an operator of a public conveyance, or by the operator himself or herself, shall subject such offender to a fine of not less than three hundred pesos (P300.00) for the first offense and cancellation of his/her permit for the succeeding offense and disqualifying him or her to be granted permit for the exercise of such vocation or privilege within the jurisdiction of Ormoc City.

SECTION 10. Separability. - If any section or portion of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or ultra vires, such declaration shall not invalidate the whole of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
