RESOLUTION NO. 1228

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, on motion of Kagawad Besa-
bella, seconded jointly by Mga Kagawad Samson and Santiago;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

TAX ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TAX ORDINANCE NO. 7, OTHERWISE KNOWN
AS THE "ORMOC CITY BUS TERMINAL SERVICES ORDINANCE"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. Amendment. - Section 4 of Tax Ordinance No. 7, other-
wise known as the "Ormoc City Bus Terminal Services Ordinance", is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. Fees and rentals or contracts. - There shall be
levied upon and imposed on every passenger bus or jeepney, includ-
ing private utility vehicles, a terminal fee and/or rental, as the
case may be, for services rendered and facilities offered for
parking or loading purposes, which shall be paid to the City Trea-
surer or his duly authorized representative according to their
respective categories as follows:

	Per Trip	Overnight Parking
a) Passenger bus	₱ 7.00	₱ 12.00
b) Passenger jeepney	2.00	4.00
c) <u>Private utility vehicle</u>	<u>7.00</u>	<u>12.00</u>

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That should a contract be necessary with any
interested person, bus or jeepney operator, or if a contractual
relationship for the use of the premises is deemed more conven-
ient for both parties rather than the imposition of fees pres-
cribed herein, then the basic rental shall not be less than three
thousand pesos (₱3,000.00) per month per bay but in no case shall
the whole terminal be awarded to a single operator: PROVIDED, FUR-
THER, That the contract or covenant shall be entered into and/or
signed by the City Mayor under such terms and conditions as he may
deem appropriate: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That in no case shall the
premises be converted into a garage for vehicles and neither shall
major repairs be undertaken thereat: and PROVIDED, FINALLY, That
not more than three (3) passenger buses shall be allowed in each
bay at any one time and that in cases of jeepneys any such number
may be allowed provided that they shall not go beyond the bounde-
aries of their leased lanes or bays.

SECTION 2. Amendment. - Tax Ordinance No. 7 is hereby amended by

inserting a new section thereof between Sections Five and Six to be known as Section Five-A and shall read as follows:

"SECTION 5.-A. Canvasser's fee. - A duly licensed canvasser shall be allowed to collect from operators the sums of not more than Two Pesos (P2.00) for each jeepney and not more than Four Pesos (P4.00) for each bus per trip.

SECTION 3. Effectivity. - This Tax Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, September 14, 1982.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the City Treasurer and all bus and jeepney operators, canvassers, and private utility vehicle owners, through the City Dispatcher, this city;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
