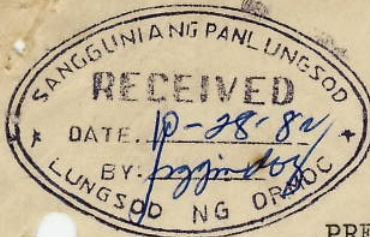

RESOLUTION NO. 1253

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, on motion of Kagawad Besa-
bella, seconded jointly by Mga Kagawad Mendola, Bandalan and Codilla;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

TAX ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 4.1.1.13 AND 4.1.3.6
OF TAX ORDINANCE NO. 1, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE
"ORMOC REVENUE CODE OF 1977."

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. Tax Code Amendment to Section 4.1.1.13. - Section
4.1.1.13 of Tax Ordinance No. 1, otherwise known as the "Ormoc City
Revenue Code of 1977", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4.1.1.13. Fees from Persons Selling in Trucks,
Boats and the Market Vicinity. - The City Treasurer, through
his authorized representatives in the city markets, shall col-
lect fees from persons selling merchandise in trucks, in convey-
ances or in boats docked or moored in the waters of the harbors
in the vicinity of the city markets or in any other places with-
in the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Ormoc according
to the following schedule of rates:

<u>Merchandise or Animals</u>	<u>Per Head</u>
Carabao	P 5.00
Cow	5.00
Goat or Sheep	2.00
Pig, large size	2.00
Pig, medium size	1.00
Pig, small size	1.00
Chicken	0.20
<u>Firewood</u>	<u>Per 100 Bundles</u>
First or Second Class	P 1.00
<u>Nipa</u>	<u>Per 100 Pieces</u>
First or Second Class	P 1.00

It shall be the duty of operators and/or drivers of trucks,
captains or skippers or watercrafts and other conveyances con-
taining merchandise upon arrival in any city market and before
unloading and/or selling or offering for sale the merchandise or

animals carried in the same immediately to report to the Market Collectors their presence in the said market in order that the latter could determine the exact amount of fees they are required to pay: Provided, however, That any violation of this provision shall render such owner or owners subject to the payment of special fees representing twice the amount of market fees to be determined pursuant to the capacity and/or volume of merchandise so unloaded or sold without previous notification to the Market Administrator or to the Market Collectors as provided in this Section."

SECTION 2. Tax Code Amendment to Section 4.1.3.6. - Section 4.1.3.6 of Tax Ordinance No. 1, otherwise known as the "Ormoc City Revenue Code of 1977", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 4.1.3.6. Market Hours. - The public markets shall be open for the sale of articles or merchandise permitted for sale therein from THREE o'clock in the morning until TEN o'clock in the evening every day."

SECTION 3. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, October 19, 1982.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the City, Treasurer, Market Collectors, Stall Holders, and all others concerned, all in Ormoc City;
