
EXPLANATORY NOTE

NG ORMO is enacted pursuant to Article X, Section 5 of the Constitution which grants to each Local Government Unit the power to create its own sources of revenues and levy taxes, fees and charges subject to such quivelines and limitations as the Congress may provide consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy, which taxes, fees and charges shall accrue exclusively to the Local Governments.

aforementioned constitutional provision is operationalized by Section 186 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 71.00, which provides: "Local government units may exercise the power to taxes, fees or charges on any base or subject not otherwise fically enumerated herein or taxed under the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or other applicable laws: rrovided, That the taxes, fees or charges shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy: Provided, further, that the ordinance levying such taxes, fees or charges shall not be enacted without any prior public hearing conducted for the purpose."

Presently, there is no ordinance which regulates the utilization of walls of City Government-owned buildings/structures for paint/print commercial advertisements, or for any other purpose.

RESOLVED, to pass and enact;

TAX ORDINANCE NO. 2001-001

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND FIXING THE RENTAL OF PAINTED/PRINTED COMMERCIAL ADVERTISEMENTS, OR FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE, ON WALLS OF CITY GOVERNMENT-OWNED BUILDINGS/STRUCTURES.

BE IT ENACTED, by the 8TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD π_9 DRMON, in REGULAR SESSION assembled that:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the ORDINANCE REGULATING AND FIXING THE RENTAL OF PAINTED/PRINTED COMMERCIAL ADVERTISEMENTS, OR FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE, DA WALLS OF CITY GOVERNMENTOWNED BUILDINGS/STRUCTURES.

SECTION 2. It shall be illegal for any person to paint/print commercial advertisements, or for any purpose, an walds of city government-owned buildings/structures without first securing the necessary permit from the Office of the City Mayor, and thereafter to pay the corresponding rental as herein provided.

No other modes of advertisement except painting/printing on walls of City Government-owned buildings/structures shall be allowed.

SECTION 3. For painting/printing commercial advertisements or for any other purpose, on walls of city government-owned buildings/structures, a rental of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (#150.00) per source veter or a greation thereof, per month shall be paid.

SECTION 4. For the above-purpose, the city government of Ormoc, represented by the City Mayor or his duly authorized representative, and the advertiser-lessee shall enter into a contract of lease, a copy of which shall be furnished this Sanggunian, which shall provide among others:

- that the rental shall be paid in advance within the first ten (10) days of the month applicable;
- 2. that an advance rental for one (1) month shall be paid, and an amount equivalent to two (2) months rental shall be deposited to answer for the cost in restoring the area to its original state upon the expiration of the contract in the event that the advertiser-lessee fails to undertake the restoration thereof, as provided for in the succeeding paragraph.
- 3. that the advertiser-lessee shall restore the area to its original state within 10 days after the expiration of the lessee contract, otherwise, the city government of Ormoc will cause the restoration of the area using for the purpose his deposit, and if deficient, to bill him for the deficiency; otherwise, whatever excess, if any, shall be returned to the advertiser-lessee or the full amount thereof, if the restoration is fully and satisfactorily undertaken by him;
- 4. that the advertiser-lessee shall not sub-lease nor allow third persons to use the leased premises without first securing the written consent of the City Mayor.

That all amount due from the advertiser-lessee shall be paid at the Office of the City Treasurer of Ormoc which shall issue the corresponding official receipt therefor.

SECTION 5. Any person found guilty of violating section two hereof, shall suffer the penalty of fine of not more than Five Hundred Pesos (₱500.00) or imprisonment of not less than one (1) month, or both fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 6. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it shall have been posted at conspicuous places in Ormoc City for three (3) consecutive weeks and published once in a newspaper of general circulation in Ormoc City.
